John David Rathbun, Jr. died on November 27th, 2020 in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. He was 80 years old. His kind and generous life impacted everyone he met. He truly never met a person he did not like.

He was very proud of his son John becoming an Eagle Scout and later his grandson William (who he helped build his Eagle Scout project).

He was a huge Green Bay Packer fan and will be pulling for the Pack from heaven. He was a fixture at the Tulsa Packer Backer watch parties. He was also a devoted Oklahoma Sooner fan, since both of his boys attended school there, as well as three grandchildren.
