God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son, so that whosoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life. John 3:16

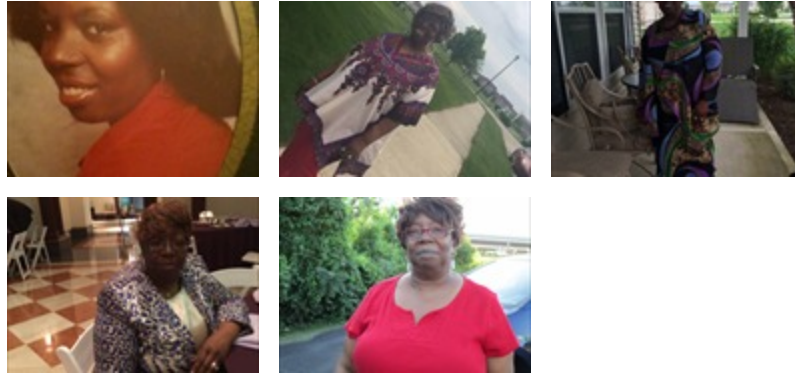

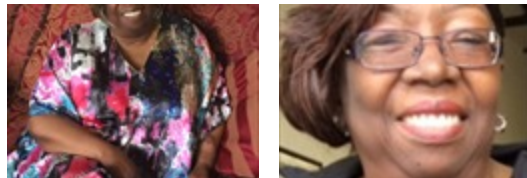
