Bruce Phillip Lang, age 69, passed away suddenly on September 30, 2022 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Born November 9, 1953 at Offutt AFB in Nebraska, Bruce was the 6th child of 7 and the 4th son of Dolores Patricia (Aguirre) and Howard Alfred Lang of Sioux City, Iowa.

Bruce entered the U.S. Marine Corps after high school and was stationed in Hong Kong and Washington, DC. Later he lived and worked in St. Joseph, Missouri, where his daughters Waynette(Lang) Haines and Kimberly (Lang) Palmer were born. He relocated to Tulsa, Oklahoma, to be close to his sisters Pamela Joan Brown and (Mary) Patricia Meadows. In Tulsa, he worked for American Airlines as a flight service clerk. The last many years of his life, Bruce lived with his brother and sister of many years, Brian and Ann McCumber.

He is preceded in death by his parents and his sisters as well as brothers, Joseph Paul and David Howard Lang. Surviving are his daughters, Waynette (Mike) and Kimberly, grandchildren Tristan and Emerson Haines and Junior and Chevy Palmer, brothers Ronald John Aguirre and Michael Howard Lang, many of his 38 nieces and nephews, and his closest brother, Brian, and his family.

tradition. A friend of Bill W. for more than 25 years, he was involved in the Circle Meetings for many years when they were active in Tulsa.

A faithful Christian, Bruce was devoted to our Lord God, the Great Spirit. He wrote and said the BEST prayers when someone was in need. He shared Bible verses daily and had online discussions about them. Bruce cared deeply for his family and friends. He will be missed by all who knew him.
