Clyde Bailey, 84, passed away due to advanced Parkinson's Disease on August 4, 2022. Clyde was born and raised in Vinita, OK. Clyde graduated from Vinita High School and married Daloma McCombs on May 3, 1957. Clyde and Daloma then moved to Minneapolis, MN where Clyde was employed at the VA Hospital. They later returned to Vinita and he was employed at Craig General Hospital as a physical therapist for many years. Around 1975 Clyde left the hospital and took over his father's pest control business, Bailey's Pest Control, which he operated until his retirement in 2020. Clyde loved fishing, camping, and spending time with his family. Clyde was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses in 1963 and devoted his life to talking with people about God's Kingdom.

Clyde and wife, Daloma, of the home, had five children, two sons, Brent Bailey and wife Mary of Gilmer, TX, Mark Bailey and wife Angie of Vinita, and three daughters, Debbie Paulding and husband Mark, Sheri Fulton and husband David, and Jennifer Manners and husband Ronnie, all of Vinita. Clyde had 18 grandchildren and numerous great grandchildren. Clyde will be dearly missed by his family & friends. He was known as a helpful, kind, and patient man by anyone who knew him.
