Cynthia Ann Courtwright was born November 6, 1943 to Victor and Lucille Courtwright in Tahlequah, OK. She married her high school sweetheart, Michael Prendergast on June 15, 1962 in Muskogee, OK. To this union two daughters were born Shannon Pate (Tim) of Coweta, OK, and Victoria "Vicki" Scott (Emmett) of Tulsa, OK.

She and Michael settled in Checotah in the early 1970's where she worked as an Administrative Assistant at the BIA and IHS for many years. They moved to Nashville where she made many close friends while she ran the office for their auto-trim design business. They eventually moved to Coweta, OK where they were welcomed into Shannon and Tim's home. After Michael's death, she continued work in Billing until she retired.
