He was always up for gaming challenges; video, board games, cribbage, card games of all sorts. David was a hard worker & had so many abilities; including gardening, fixing & building things, cooking & teaching his children & nephew how to cook; he really enjoyed good food & excelled at hospitality. He was always proud of his Native American heritage. Friends & neighbors recount that he had a good heart & would do anything he could to help someone else. He was very patriotic to our country & loved displaying our USA flag & wearing USA clothing; he upheld & taught patriotism to his children & nephew. David suffered from depression for years and also with alcoholism. We lost

him in late September this year from suicide. Those of us who were close to David and knew him will always miss him; we will be broken hearted forever. R.I.P. Our Dear One. (There's not enough room for words to sum up your precious life to me; I love you eternally my dear son; I hold you forever in my heart. Momma.)

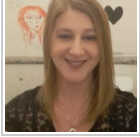
