



## David Emmitt Kaser

September 18, 1964 - February 9, 2021

David Emmitt Kaser was born in Salina Kansas on September 18, 1964.

He is survived by wife, Teresa Kaser; sons Adam Kaser and family, Kenan Kaser and family, Vincent Kaser and family and Calvin Kaser; father Donald Kaser; sisters Sharon Kite and Theresa Walker and brother John Kaser along with their families.

He is preceded in death by his daughters Clarissa Kaser and Crystal "Grey" Kaser; his mother Helen Koger Kaser; his maternal and paternal grandparents; some aunts and uncles; and his mother and father-in-law John and Antionette Moore.

David graduated from Sapulpa schools and married Loretta Hall. Adam Kaser was born of their union. David briefly served in the Air Force. After he and Loretta divorced, he met Teresa Moore Bishop and the two were married on December 18, 1987 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. They resided in Tulsa, then moved to the Kansas City area for employment. Their first child, Kenan Kaser was born in Blue Springs, Missouri on May 18, 1992. While he was still an infant the family returned to Tulsa where David completed the Master Welder program at Tulsa Vo-Tech. Vincent Kaser joined the family on May 9, 1994, followed by Calvin Kaser on September 23, 1996 and Clarissa Kaser on July 16, 2001.

Shortly after Clarissa's birth, David and Teresa moved the family to Ohio where David pursued a Graphic Design degree at Columbus College of Art and Design. In 2004 the family moved back home to the Tulsa area. Crystal Kaser arrived on March 23, 2006.

David's welding career ended late in 2008 when he suffered disabling back issues from heavy lifting and strenuous work. David had a strong work ethic and took great pride in his work and always strived to provide for his family.

His favorite interests were scuba diving in the ocean, which he experienced while stationed in Guam with the U.S. Air Force; hot rods; graphic and general art and coming up with ideas for inventions. His life came to a tragic and sudden end on February 9, 2021.
