Biography

Funeral services for Seminole native Dennis Ray Grisham are scheduled for Tuesday, May 1, 2012 at 11:00 at Serenity Funeral Chapel, Tulsa. His childhood friend, Daniel Factor of Akvsmvka Baptist Church in Wewoka will officiate. Burial will follow in Brooken Cemetery, north of Enterprise, OK where Dennis had made his home for many years. Dennis died Thursday April 26, 2012 at Clarehouse, a hospice facility in Tulsa. He was born Sept. 12, 1952 in Seminole to Houston A. and Rita (Burkhart) Grisham. He graduated from New Lima High School and attended Seminole State College. He made his living as a sand dredge operator, until he was injured in a serious accident in 1985. Following his accident, he retired to Lake Eufaula, where he raised one son, Dennis Grisham, Jr. He was a member of Mountain Home Baptist Church in Stigler, OK. He was preceded in death by his father; one brother, James Randal Grisham; his paternal grandparents, J.M. and Mollie Grisham; and his paternal grandparents, Oather and Ivy Burkhart. Survivors include his mother and step-father, Rita and Don Lester of Seminole; his son and daughter-in-law, Dennis Jr. and Brooke Grisham of Oklahoma City; one sister and brother-in-law, Karen and Jerry Anson of Seminole; two brothers and a sister-in-law, Larry Grisham of Seminole, and Terry and Terrie Grisham of Tulsa; two grandsons, Dennis Grisham III (Trey) and Seth Grisham of Oklahoma City;
