



Eugene Corky Osburn

February 15, 1944 - September 20, 2018

Eugene "Corky" Osburn entered this world on February 15, 1944 and departed to be with his heavenly father on September 24, 2018. Eugene was preceded in death by his parents Macie Eslinger Osburn and William D. "Buster" Osburn.

Corky was one of six children born to Buster and Macie. The Osburns owned and operated a farm and a general store in Liberty, Oklahoma and eventually opened Osburns Grocery in Tahlequah, Oklahoma.

Corky was a veteran of the armed forces having served 25 years in the Army National Guard.

Corky worked as a carpenter, home builder and later as a machinist in his civilian life. Eugene was a hard worker and worked all of his life. He was employed by Nelson Electric in Tulsa for over 20 years until they became OZ Gedney and eventually Continental Industries until his death.

He married Treva Tickeater in 1972 and had two daughters of that marriage, Linda Christina Osburn Springer and Eugenia Zoretta Osburn Shannon. Corky welcomed and loved Treva's daughter, Leona Faye Fielden, as his own.

His hobbies included fishing, card games and playing on softball leagues in Tulsa. In his later years he enjoyed putting together puzzles and spending

time with his grandchildren. Everyone who knew Corky, knew that he played horseshoes and was an expert horseshoe pitcher. Corky enjoyed listening to old gospel hymns and was a fan of Elvis. One of his favorite memories was taking his grandchildren on a tour of Graceland.

Corky is survived by his three daughters, seven grandchildren, and fourteen great grandchildren, his brother Gilbert Osburn of Lawrence, Kansas; Ronnie Osburn and wife Judy of Guthrie, Oklahoma and John Osburn and wife Linda of Siloam Springs, Arkansas, his twin Irene Stone of Texas, and sister Margie Swim and husband Mike of Tahlequah, Oklahoma and a host of nieces and nephews.

A private memorial service will be held in Tahlequah, Oklahoma on Sunday, October 7th.

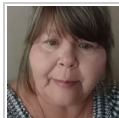
