SCHELL, FINIS GERALD (JERRY), loving husband, dad and grandpa passed from this life on Monday, February 13, 2017 in Tulsa, OK. He was born May 24, 1922 in Washburn, MO to John Floyd Schell and Effie Pauline (Baker) Schell. Jerry spent his early years in Owasso, OK on a dairy farm, graduating from Owasso High School in 1940. He served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during WWII as a 1st Lt. Bombardier in the European Theater completing 70 missions, including one for which he earned the Silver Star Medal. In 1946, Jerry married his sweetheart Claudine Ruth (Pittman) Schell after meeting her at Crystal City amusement park in West Tulsa. In 1949, Jerry and Claudine had their beloved daughter, Judy. Jerry also completed his Bachelor of Geology degree in 1949 at the University of Tulsa. After several years living in Tulsa, Jerry moved his family to an acreage in Broken Arrow, OK where they would enjoy a life with horses and wildlife. Jerry spent 38 years with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in Tulsa where he designed highways and bridges as a civil engineer from 1951-1989. Upon retirement, he took his bride to live for 19 years at Flint Ridge near Kansas, OK. The family spent many weekends visiting our 'daddy' and 'grandpa' at their log cabin near the Illinois River in the Ozarks. Jerry's family was blessed again when he and Claudine came back to Tulsa in 2013 to be even closer to family. Jerry loved working with numbers, western movies, big band and Nashville sound music, playing golf with his friend Al, fried catfish, homemade ice cream, his cat Abe, his dog

Cokie, and most of all, his family. Jerry was preceded in death by his parents, by his in-laws Chester and Sarah Pittman, and his sister, Flora Ellen Fullerton. He is survived by his wife Claudine Ruth Schell, daughter Judy Snively and husband Austin of Talala, OK, granddaughter Rachel Boeckman and husband Tim of Tulsa, OK, granddaughter Gretchen Spraker of Tulsa, OK, and his nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
