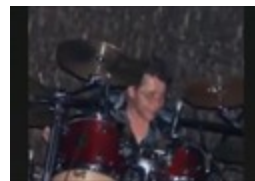
Derek, Micheal, Christine, MacKenzie, Novah, Connor, and Kaley.
