Leroy also had two up and coming horses that he was so

excited about; a dun called Levi and a paint horse called Son. Leroy had a black Western Hauler dually that he loved and could be found under the hood whenever he had a free moment. Leroy could operate and "fix" any piece of equipment and was proud of his work at Earthsmart Construction where he was the Superintendent of Production and Shop Operations and good friends with the owner, Rex Gibson and his family.
