Karl Christian Modenbach Jr., 90, died February 21, 2023 at his home in Tulsa. Friends and family were with Karl as he prepared to pass from this life to his eternal one. Karl was born to Karl Christian Modenbach Sr. and Ruth (Young) Modenbach on December 2, 1932 in Oklahoma City. Karl lived in Oklahoma the majority of his life. He earned a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Tulsa while working full time. The majority of Karl's employment was in tubular sales in the oil and gas industry, although he did work in accounting for a period of time.

Karl was preceded in death by his parents, his wife Jaylene, his infant daughter Konnie Jo, his adult son Ricky J. and two sisters, Mary Janeway and Ann Hughes. Karl is survived by his brother Richard, and numerous nieces and nephews as well as a host of friends he and Jaylene developed during their sixty-one years of marriage, as well as new friends Karl gained in the nearly seven years since Jaylene's death.
