Larry Lee Ashlock of Mannford, OK, passed away October 12, 2021, at the age of 63 years old, after suffering 25 days in the hospital from a biological warfare also known as COVID.

Larry was born to Donald Chester Ashlock and Vida Mae Kendrick on July 31, 1958, in Turley, OK. In 1979, he married Glenda Faye Fort and had two children, Brandon and Krystal.

For several years he worked as a welder and then as an inspector for refineries traveling around Oklahoma and the country. He hosted an annual family reunion at his home with everyone enjoying his pool. Most days you would find him in his overalls working the cattle. Always available to others, Larry provided guidance, direction, and prayers to friends and family alike.
