



## Phillip Lee Heideman

April 7, 1941 - November 29, 2019

Phillip Heideman, was born in Sheboygan, WI on April 7, 1941 to Leland and Ida Heideman. He received his B.B.A. from the University of Wisconsin and also graduated from Northwestern College in Iowa. He met and married his wife, Sharon Colantonio (of 35 years) at a Bible Study in MI and they moved to TX shortly after where he began his studies at Dallas Theological Seminary. In 1970, he earned his Th.M. degree in New Testament Literature and Exegesis from Dallas Theological Seminary. Shortly after, they moved to Muskogee, OK, with their first born, Suzanne, where he pastored Grace Bible Church. In 1982, they moved to Tulsa with 3 more children in tow, Mark, Daniel, and Stephanie where he worked as a C.P.A.. He also conducted the correspondence division of studies at Chafer Theological Seminary. He worked at Pennwell Publishing company until he retired in 2015. He regularly exercised and ran in the Tulsa Run for nearly 20 years. He enjoyed reading and studying the Bible, politics, and Wisconsin football.

After retiring, he continued to work hard, volunteering as a Bible teacher for prison inmates, Pakistan pastors, Ukrainian Pastors, John 3:16 Rescue Mission, and occasionally in his class on Sunday mornings. He also, recently, taught a class on Biblical Greek in his church. On Friday morning, November 29th, he went home to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He was preceded in death by his parents, Leland and Ida; sister, Jane; wife, Sharon; and daughter, Suzanne. He is survived by his son, Mark and wife, Jennifer; son Daniel and wife Heidi; daughter, Stephanie and husband Jason; and 10

grandchildren, Caleb, Annalyse, Cadence, Alysa, Trinity, Eli, Titus, Zayne, Kyrie, and Gloria.
