Pik Shun Yip, 86, of Tulsa, Oklahoma went to be with her Lord Jesus Christ on March 20, 2024 at 5:27 pm.

She was born on May 17, 1937 in Chishui a town in the Guangdong province of China the daughter of Sing Lam Szeto and Kim Sal Yee.

She married the love of her life, Loi Sing Yip, in 1962 and soon afterwards Charlie Yip was born. The family emigrated from England to the United States in 1963. Michael Yip was born in 1966 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. In 1971, Loi and Shun had the opportunity to purchase the Golden Dragon restaurant located on 41st and Memorial. It was renamed "Loi's Golden Dragon".

Under their management, the restaurant was a huge success. Loi ran the kitchen and Shun managed everything else. Because of her matriarchal status, she was given the nickname "Momma Shun" by many of her regular customers. The entire family operated the business for 23 years until it was sold to her younger sister in 1994. In 1995, the family opened Loi's China Cafe in Claremore and operated it for 5 years.

Shun was more than just a restaurateur. She was a mentor to many employees who were working their way through school. Because of her entrepreneurial spirit, many of her employees went on to open their own

highly successful businesses.

Beyond her role as a business owner, Shun was a devoted family woman, friend and adviser to many. Although she was a generous person, she never stopped showing gratitude to the many people who helped her in the early years as an immigrant. She is survived by Michael, daughter-in-law Kelly, and many grandchildren. They will continue to honor her memory and carry forward her legacy.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Loi Sing Yip and oldest son, Charlie Koon Ying Yip.

Pik Shun Yip accepted our Lord Jesus Christ very late in life. Because of the account of the penitent thief (Luke 23:39–43; Matthew 27:38–44) we shall be forever grateful to God who is rich in mercy and grace.
