Robert Clyde Duncan, 57, of Tulsa, passed away Sunday, Jan. 4, 2015, at his home in Tulsa.

Robert was born Nov. 9, 1957, to Burt and Stella Duncan in Washington, D.C. He was known to his family and childhood friends as Bobby. He attended school in Germany, Wynnewood and Virginia. Bobby graduated from Garfield High School at Woodbridge, Va., in 1975. After graduating from high school Bobby attended Hagerstown Junior College at Hagerstown, Md. He was named to the All-Maryland Junior College and National Junior College Track teams for the 1976 outdoor track season in the 400 meter relay and the 200-meter dash. He was also vice president of the Student Government Association at Hagerstown. He graduated from the College of William and Mary at Williamsburg, Va., in 1979. He was on the 1978 and 1979 track team at William and Mary. Bobby received his master's degree from Southwestern Oklahoma State University after moving to Oklahoma.

Bobby was a professor of American history and federal government, and he wrote several books and papers on history and government. He was a Baltimore Orioles baseball fan and loved going to the games with his parents. Bobby was preceded in death by his parents: Burton C. and Stella L Duncan. He is survived by six aunts; four uncles; 16 cousins; and friend, Trisha Webster, of Tulsa.
