Terry Grisham Funeral services for Seminole native Terry Dwayne Grisham are scheduled for 2 p.m. Friday, Sept. 18, at Brooken Cemetery, Kinta, Okla., on Eufaula Lake. Pastor Dan Factor will officiate; burial will be under the direction of Serenity Funerals in Tulsa. Terry died Sunday, Sept. 13, 2015, at his home in Tulsa. He was born Dec. 18, 1957, in Seminole to Rita (Burkhart) Grisham and Houston Grisham. He attended school at New Lima for 12 years, moving to Tulsa after high school. He worked as a concrete truck driver for Sheldon Ready Mix. Anyone who ever knew Terry will remember him by his nickname, Hinky, and will remember his larger-than-life stories. He filled every room with his smile, his silvery white hair and beard, looking and acting every day like the lively, laughing, lovable Santa Claus he portrayed at Christmas. He drew out every person from the smallest child to the oldest grandparent. But he was never happier than when he was camping with his father, uncles, brothers, cousins, nephews and grandsons, fishing or hunting deer by day and telling tales by the fire at night. He was married to Terrie Roybal-Grisham for 26 years. She survives him, of the home.
