Teddy liked to mechanic, like his dad and he enjoyed playing with his nieces and nephews, who all loved him very much.

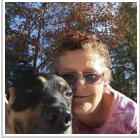

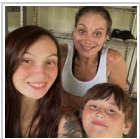
“ Teddy was a great guy. I will miss him.
