Timothy F. Carroll, born August 10, 1958, passed away November 12, 2016, in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Tim loved radio from a very young age, creating a pirate radio station with his neighbor Larry LaBuz as preteens and paying Larry's sister Laurie a quarter per hour to listen. He worked at 11 different radio stations across Oklahoma in pretty much every position, eventually co-owning his own station in Ely, Nevada. Even at the end, he left a CD so he could DJ his own funeral. Tim had an interesting life. He encountered several ghosts, helped produce a B movie called "Vigilante Blood," once climbed the side of the Zingo roller coaster, and was carjacked twice by the same man. Tim will be remembered as an intelligent, funny, optimistic yet cynical, kind curmudgeon who didn't have much but would give you whatever he had, loved to help people, and never met a stranger. He had a thirst for knowledge, especially about abandoned missile silos and underground bunkers, and designed self-sufficient communities in his free time. Tim loved animals, would often talk to the birds in the yard--once offering a hummingbird a chocolate chip cookie--and looked forward to baby chicken season at Atwoods every year. He loved comedy, especially Looney Tunes, the Three Stooges, and Laurel and Hardy. He is survived by his mother Peggy Carroll, sister Paula Hamby, brother David Carroll, brother Carl Carroll, and daughter Tiffany French, who imagine him in heaven with his brother Bill, making jokes with Groucho Marx and complaining about the food.
