On August 8, 1953, a son was born to Ambrosia and Oretha (Wilburn)Wallace in Tallahassee, Oklahoma. They named him Timothy Eugene, who was nicknamed Tim. Tim was born with some health issues, and they were uncertain if he would survive. But he was a fighter and survived just like the last eight months. Tim was intelligent and could do almost anything he put his mind to. He was constantly in trouble because of his curiosity. If it was a clock, radio, or anything electronic, he loved to take it apart and he could put it back together after being threatened by his mother.

He was educated in the Tulsa Public School System and graduated from Booker T. Washington High School Class of 1972. After high school, he enlisted in the United States Marine Corps, and then he enlisted in the United States Army. He received Honorable discharges from both branches. After his military duties, he met and married his first wife, Sheila Hartman. They had four children and divorced after 17 years.

Tim transitioned into eternal rest on Thursday July 6, 2023. The word of God says to be 'absent from the body, is to be present with the Lord.' His father and mother, Ambrosia and Oretha Wallace, preceded him in death, along with sisters Uearlene Norma Jean Howard and Girlie Dean Gilmore and brother Cecil (BoBo) Earl Wallace.

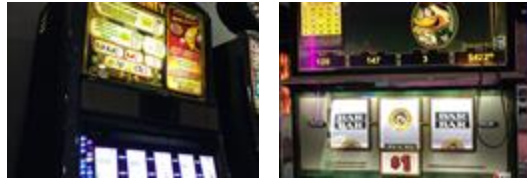
